

My name is Dave, and I live in the Denver Colorado area. In June of 2013 I was experiencing severe abdominal pain; it affected my eating and sleeping habits drastically. I was losing an average of 12 pounds a week. The doctors ran every test they could think of looking for a cause of the pain and loss of appetite with negative results at the end of each test.
