

Thunderstorm in a Bottle: Introducing Watt-Ahh Water

Breakthrough Advances in Lightning Polarization

Do you know what lightning tastes like? I do... in a manner of speaking.

"According to the rules of chemistry, this water cannot exist," explained inventor and CEO of AquaNew LLC, Rob Gourley, when I sat down with he, his wife Dana (COO), Melinda Lagasse (Director of Marketing), and loyal advocate Diana Demby. Gourley, along with a team of chemists, developed electrically charged polarized water called "Watt-Ahh," unveiled for the first time publicly on November 17 at Efest 2007 in Sarasota. But it does exist, and the potential health and environmental benefits are astonishing.

"What we were trying to do," Rob told me, "was imitate what nature has done for millions upon millions of years. Here in Florida, you can see the prime examples. When you water your lawn, the grass doesn't die, but it doesn't really grow. However, you get a lightning storm here with a little bit of rain, and the grass is four inches taller a day later. What's the difference?"

The difference, Melinda informed me, is that water not evaporated by a lightning strike becomes polarized. It is that magnetic polarization that helps create water in its purest form, the way it was meant to be hundreds of years ago, before rain water became contaminated by man-created pollutants in the atmosphere.

Dana pointed out that many of the distilled, spring, and purified waters contain 200 or more dissolved solids (which are traces of sand, metal, and other contaminants). Watt-Ahh contains fewer than one dissolved solid particle per million. What this means is that you are taking into your body a non-toxic, bacteria-free water that is easily absorbed at a cellular level (dissolving metabolites in your blood). Since all known pathogens are carried in water, imagine non-pathogenic water that can rid your body of toxins.

Diana Demby is such a believer in this newly developed "holy water" that it was important for her to meet with us to share her stories. According to Demby, she no longer has stabbing arthritis pain in her hands, and her ankles are no longer swollen after standing for long periods of time. She sleeps better, her blood pressure is significantly reduced, and she's noticed that while she would usually get sick when people around her would get the flu, she hasn't caught any of the bugs that seem to be floating around lately. Gardeners and farmers reported plants and crops growing at a 30 percent more rapid rate, and many households are opting for Watt-Ahh in a spray bottle for household cleaning in place of harsh detergents.

I had the privilege of seeing their lab but am sworn to secrecy while potentially earth-changing (literally) inventions are being developed. What I can tell you is this: Watt-Ahh is triple-processed, pharmaceutical-grade water. Starting with spring water, it is then filtered by reverse osmosis. It

then goes through a deionization (imagine magnets pulling resin out) process, followed by steam distillation (condensing and softening the water). Finally, it is infused with a hydro gas (a second form of water) and, ta-da! Watt-Ahh.
